Pedestrians injured in Melbourne, Australia— 21st December 2017

The National Co-ordinator Protect and Prepare is aware an incident that has taken place in Melbourne, Australia that occurred at about 16:40 (Australian Time) in which a number of pedestrians have been struck by a moving vehicle.

- A car, thought to be a white Suzuki SUV, crashed into pedestrians in one of the busiest areas of Melbourne's CBD, outside Flinders street station, after 4.30pm.
- A number of casualties have been transported to hospital. One was a pre-school aged child with a serious head injury. The injured have been taken to hospitals across the city.
- Two people have been arrested. One was the driver. Police have saturated the area and blocked off key parts of the CBD. *(Source - The Guardian Online)*

We are currently liaising with the Australian Authorities.

At this time, the motivation behind the incident has not been confirmed.

NCTPHQ are monitoring the incident and if appropriate will provide further information through CSSC.
