#### **What is *ACT Awareness eLearning*?**

It's an online training programme that has been developed in a partnership between *Counter Terrorism Policing* and high street retailer, *Marks & Spencer*. The training helps organisations from SMEs through to large corporates better understand, and mitigate against, current terrorist methodology. To date, over 1500 companies have registered across the UK.

## Key Facts

- Access to the e-learning is completely free of charge.
- Companies may register to receive their own URL link and PIN, or can request a SCORM1.2 compliant file to deliver the training within in-house learning management systems.
- The course takes approximately 45 minutes to complete. It is split into seven modules, taking between 5-10 minutes each to complete.
- The training is proving particularly popular with retail, entertainment and sports venues.
